

Takayama Autumn Festival (Hachiman Matsuri)

Welcome to the 2024 Takayama Autumn Festival.

Even though the origin of the festival is unknown, it is believed that it started between 1586 and 1692 when the Kanamori family governed the Hida Takayama area. Takayama Festival is regarded as one of the three most beautiful festivals in Japan, mainly due to its magnificent yatai, or festival floats, which have been preserved for around 300 years.

All floats are beautifully decorated with carvings, dolls, elaborately woven thick curtains, lacquerware, and bamboo blinds. These exquisite decorations are found not only on the outside where they are seen by the crowds, but also on the inside, such as under the roof and behind the doors, where elaborate carvings are waiting to be seen.
